Frequently asked questions

Can I build my workshop myself?

Of course you can! The fella behind SHEDS4U spent years on the tools, so our kits are specifically designed to cater for every skill level, from handy-about-the-house guys to professional builders. In fact, professional builders love our kits because they're so easy to construct.

Will I need a building consent?

For buildings of workshop size, the answer is yes; any building over 30m² does (or 110m² in a rural setting – download the <brochure> to read more). But we've had heaps of experience dealing with councils, so chat to us about handling this for you.

Can my workshop have a concrete floor?

Yes! A SHEDS4U workshop doesn't need a concrete floor for structural integrity, but it's an easy add-on before or after the workshop is built. Talk to us about what thickness of concrete floor will best suit your workshop.

How secure can I make my workshop?

As secure as you like! From lockable thick steel roller doors large enough to get the real big stuff in and out to open bays if it's more of a farm set-up, how your workshop works is up to you.
